Province of NS

- Declared State of Emergency and closed the border but all truck traffic is exempt and allowed to cross the border. I would suggest calling your customers in NS as they might be closed and not able to receive your load.

Province of NB

- No changes today .

Province of PEI

- No changes today.

Province of NFLD

- No changes today.
- I have been getting a lot of messages regarding Newfoundland and Marine Atlantic. This has been addressed with Marine Atlantic and they are continuing ot follow these guidelines.
 - Will commercial drivers undergo any extra screening before the crossing?
 - Yes, all customers will be screened at the time of check-in to determine their suitability to travel.
 - If a passenger has been out of country in the last 14 days or had contact with someone with COVID-19 **and** they have COVID-19 symptoms they will **not** be permitted to travel.
 - If a passenger has been out of country in the last 14 days or had contact with someone with COVID-19 but they **are not** exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, they will be permitted to travel but will be required to be isolated at the terminal and while onboard the vessel.
 - Our goal is to provide all passengers and employees with a healthy and safe environment.
 - As such, we have implemented screening measures that include isolation areas at our terminals and onboard our vessels for those who have been out of country and require isolation as deemed by Health Canada. These measures will be strictly enforced.
 - COVID-19 is a significant public health risk and we are asking customers to help us provide a healthy and safe environment for everyone.

- Passengers directed to self-isolate must stay in the appropriate isolation areas for the duration of their travel. Passengers who refuse to comply with self-isolation directives may be denied passage or detained for additional investigation by authorities.

Province of Quebec

- Just shut down all businesses except essential services. Trucking is the exception as we are an essential service. I would encourage you to call your Quebec customers to find out if they are still open before you deliver anything in that province.

United States

Ohio, DE, MA, NY, NJ, PA, CA and MI enacted Stay at Home Order but under this order the States identified a number of essential businesses that are allowed to still operate:

- Trucking
- Moving and relocation services
- Warehousing
- Fulfillment centers
- Storage facilities
- Distribution centers
- Highways, railroads, and public transportation
- Ports
- Truck stops and fueling stations
- Repair facilities
